- We can offer a one- or two-day workshop, running from 0930 to 1630. Starting and finishing times can be amended if required.
- A sample timetable is shown overleaf for a two day course. Some variation is possible, in discussion with us. A one day course will typically include shorter sessions on: theory, assessment, differential diagnosis and treatment.
- The courses are ideal for a group of between 24 and 30 Speech and Language Therapists.
- The course will be run by one or two Speech and Language Therapists from the Nuffield Hearing and Speech Centre.
- Course fees are £750 per day (£1,500 for two days).
- Expenses are charged for normal travelling costs, overnight accommodation and meals as required. Comfortable accommodation offering single rooms with en suite bathrooms, tea /coffee facilities, telephone etc is required.
- There will be a pack of handouts – approximately 75+ sheets – for each participant, which need to be photocopied prior to the course. These will be sent to you in advance.
- As the course organiser, the responsibility for producing Course Attendance Certificates is yours, but we will be happy to sign them, if required.

The following equipment is needed at the course venue:

Video player/DVD player and screen/monitor appropriate to the venue
White board/flip chart and pens
